Significant Service Award -- Criteria:

The RI Significant Service Award recognized club projects that have:

- - -Addressed a significant problem or need in a local area (International service projects, no matter how worthy, are not eligible for this award).

- - Involved most or all of the club's members in personal rather than monetary service
- - -Been commensurate with the size of the club in it's available resources
- - Enhanced the image of Rotary in the community
- - -Been able to be emulated by other Rotary clubs

- - -Been active during the Rotary year for which the award is being given (Though it need not have been initiated, and may have been completed, in the current Rotary year).

<u>Rotary International and District Citations</u> available on Rotary.org and the District 6920 website <u>Zone Public Image Award</u> available on the Zone 33-34 Website <u>Guardian of Ethics and Vocational Excellence Award</u> nomination form available on District 6920 website.

Club of the Year will be awarded to the club that has attained the highest points in its size category. If a tie occurs, the winner will be decided by the Awards Committee while considering submissions of a Significant Service Award, progress on the Rotary International Citation as recorded in Rotary Club Central, progress toward the Public Image Citation, and other club nominations and awards.
